Transitioning Homeless Families Toward Sustainable Futures

Family Promise of St. Tammany guides homeless families on the path to achieve stable housing and financial independence through an interfaith network of compassionate care, hospitality and professional support.

How Does it Work?



Step 1: Host Congregations of all denominations provide lodging, meals, and loving support one week at a time in a rotation.



Step 2: The Day Center provides a Home Base for the families to gather each day. There is a kitchen, study rooms, living areas, and laundry.



Step 3: Transportation is provided to work, schools, daycare, and whatever else is needed for the family to carry on a regular schedule.



Step 4: Social Services agencies work alongside Family Promise to find permanent housing, jobs, and resources. Screening for substance abuse and mental health needs.



Step 5: Forever Home! Families get a home of their own and a sustainable future!

- Bridges the transition period from disadvantaged situations into sustainability
- Mentors families on career and life skills
- Serves as an after care graduate program from homelessness to having a home of their own
